

## Insurance Information



Does your child need health insurance? HAWK-I is a low cost, or free, health care coverage for children under 19 years of age. To qualify, a child must be uninsured, be ineligible for Medicaid, be a citizen of the United States and meet income limits. The cost for HAWK-I depends on your yearly income so it may be free, \$10.00 per child per month or at the most, \$20.00 per child per month.
